Veteran's Day Concert Reminder

Students report to the chorus room at <u>6:15PM</u>. Concert begins at <u>7:00PM</u>.

What?

This FREE evening concert in the Boone auditorium will features members of Men's Choir, Belles Voix, Concert Choir, Advanced Orchestra, and Wind Symphony. Invite your family, friends, teachers, etc... *Everyone is welcome!* All students will join together to perform the finale, "Battle Hymn of the Republic".

When?

The concert begins at 7:00pm. This concert will be approximately one hour. All students are expected to stay for the entire concert as they will sing a combined number at the end.

How does this affect my chorus grade?

Concerts are worth 40% of your grade. To receive an "A" for this concert, students must:

- 1. Report to the auditorium at the correct time.
- 2. Dress in concert uniform as stated.
- 3. Demonstrate appropriate concert behavior.
- 4. Follow the Code of Conduct and Dress Code.

What if I miss the concert?

The following is a summary of the concert attendance policy from the chorus handbook: Please think of your chorus concert as a "final exam" of sorts, where you display all that you have learned over the past grading period. A calendar of performances was provided in the first week of school. You have no excuse for not knowing a date of a concert. Membership in chorus requires attendance outside of the regular school day. If you know that you have a conflict with a concert date, a signed note from a parent or guardian should be received at least three weeks in advance of the concert date. If you have a last-minute emergency and cannot attend, students are expected to contact Mr. D before the concert occurs—if possible. In addition, students will need to provide a reason IN WRITING from a parent or guardian if a concert is missed. If the situation warrants an excused absence from the concert, students *may* receive a concert makeup assignment.

What do I wear?

Women

- Black chorus dress, black knee highs, and black dress shoes
- Stud earrings only, no necklaces, bracelets, rings, etc. Pearl necklaces and bracelets are welcome, however.
- Hair accessories are expected so that your hair is not in your face on stage

Men

Your chorus tuxedo, black dress socks, and black dress shoes
