About the Freedom High School Guitar Program:

For the 2011-12 year, the Freedom High School Guitar Program is one of the largest and most popular Performing Arts electives offered with over 170 students enrolled in one Guitar I class, one Guitar II class and three audition only performing classes that is our *Intermediate Guitar Ensemble*, *Advanced Guitar Ensemble* and *Advanced Guitar Orchestra*. The program encompasses yearlong accredited classes that meet one period every day during the school day. Students who successfully complete a guitar class receive one credit and also fulfill the Performing Arts elective required for graduation.

Since beginning the program 5 short years ago, the FHS Guitar Program is now recognized as one of the top high school programs in the state. Our students and ensembles continually perform at the FMEA All-State Music Conference, FMEA All-State Guitar Festival, the OCPS Honor Guitar Festival, OCPS Guitar Ensemble Music Performance Assessment as well as performing in clinics and conferences around Central Florida.

We are very excited and pleased to announce that the FHS Guitar Orchestra was invited to perform at next year's 2013 Long Island Guitar Festival located at Long Island University in New York. The LIGF is a prestigious international guitar festival that just celebrated its 20th anniversary. We are looking forward to many of our developing and talented students performing this evening to be members of our Guitar Orchestra next year.

We have enjoyed clinics from nationally renowned Guitar Professors to work with our students. They include Dr. Stephen Robinson from Stetson University, Dr. Troy Gifford from Valencia Community College, Dr. Eladio Scharrón from University of Central Florida, Bobby Koelble from the University of Central Florida/Rollins College, Rex Willis from Florida State College and Harris Becker from Long Island University, NY.
