Last school year, Mr. Perez looked at several different high school and collegiate guitar festivals across the U.S. for his ensembles to participate in. After contacting Harris Becker, Professor of Guitar at Long Island University, and submitting audition materials to LIU, the FHS Guitar Orchestra received an invitation to perform at the 21st Annual, 2013 Long Island Guitar Festival, an international level guitar festival. Impressed with the ensemble, Mr. Becker visited the FHS Guitar Program in May 2012 and spent the day working and performing with all our guitar students and ensembles as "Artist-In-Residence".

While in New York, the Guitar Orchestra will take full advantage of this educational and musical experience to visit several famous landmarks, see the musical "WICKED" at the Gershwin Theatre, share an "Articulation Concert Performance" with the Brentwood High School Guitar Club, enjoy six guitar concerts, attend two master classes and present our own LIGF Guitar Concert on Saturday, March 23, at 1:00pm in the Hillwood Recital Hall at the Tilles Performing Arts Center in Long Island University, Brooksville, New York.

With our recent FMEA performance last January and our LIGF concert next week, the FHS Guitar Program and the Guitar Orchestra are now nationally recognized as one of the top high school guitar programs and guitar ensemble. Due in part to our high profile performances, we have received numerous invitations to perform in concert at different guitar festivals from across the U.S. and plan on participating and performing at several of them in the coming years.
