After the editor gets the reviews back, the editor will send them to the author(s) with a decision about the manuscript.


Almost no manuscripts are accepted just the way they are submitted to a journal. Many are **rejected**, and some are accepted **subject to revision**. Revisions can take weeks to months, and then the revised manuscript is reviewed again.

Often a year or more passes after **initial submission** before even a good manuscript finally appears in print."
