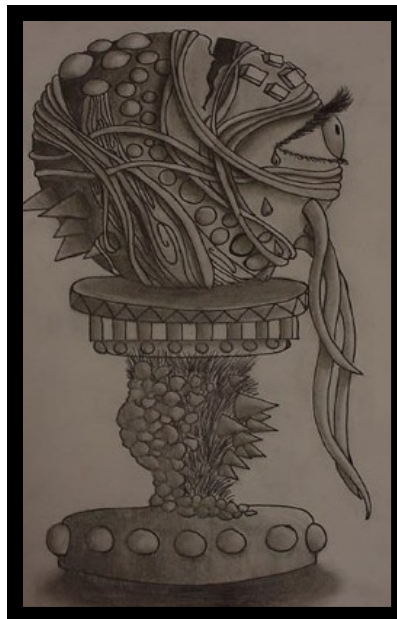

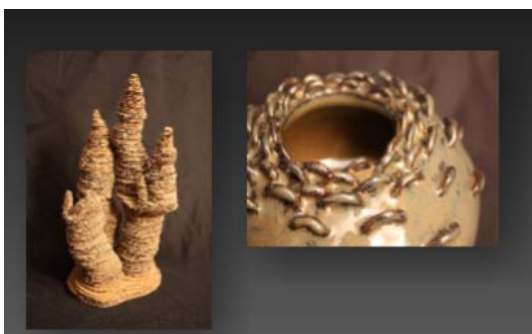
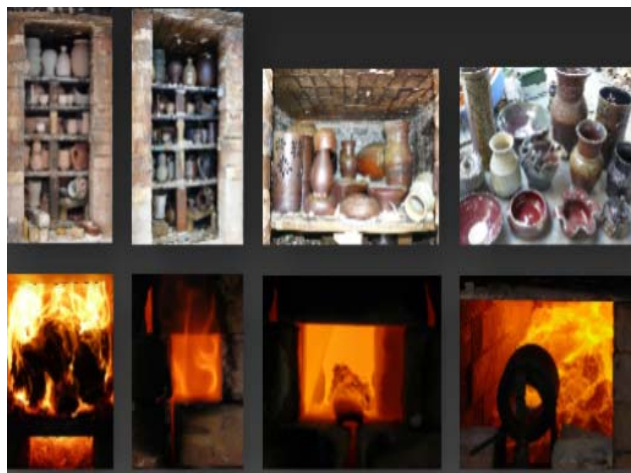




## A new year in the "hottest" class at DPHS!

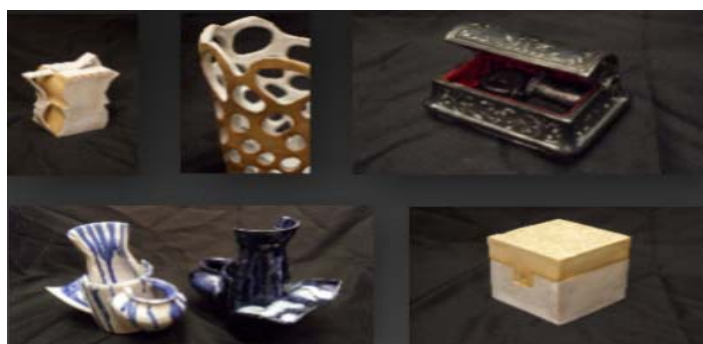
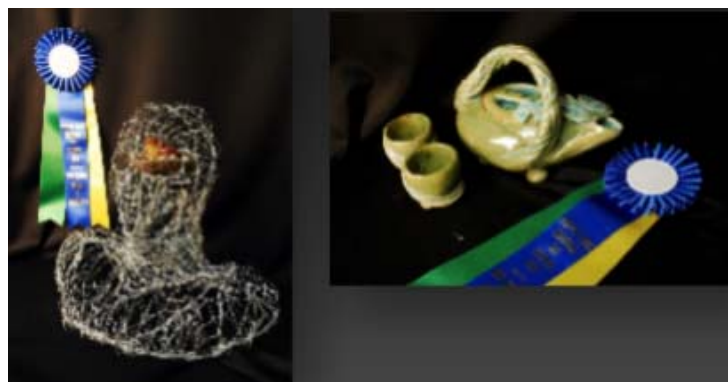
