

Mrs. Bringardner's Class Corner

My students completed several exciting units this nine weeks. They began by creating a variety of book cover illustrations. (See "Hippie" example.) Next, after studying the proportions of the human face, each student drew a male and female face. The three examples below demonstrate how each person sees and creates differently while looking at the same model. Then, we studied Seurat's pointillism and students created some beautiful original pictures using only dots. Next, we looked at works of Pablo Picasso and using oil pastels , students designed their own amazing cubism drawings. Lastly, we studied the works of M. C. Escher and students designed some fascinating original "Escheresque" tessellations.






