Flash.2.5.2

Add the comment **Complete** to frame 1 of the layer named *Text 1*.

Method of Completion:

1. Click to select frame 1 on Layer named *Text 1*
2. Click in the Name: text field under Label in the properties panel
3. Type **Complete**
4. Click the drop-down arrow for Type:
5. Click Comment

Flash.3.2.1

Swap the symbol named *BISquare* for the symbol named *RedCircle*.

Method of Completion:

1. Click on the *BISquare* symbol on the stage
2. Click Modify > Symbol > Swap Symbol
3. Click *RedCircle* from the Swap Symbol dialogue box
4. Click OK

Flash.3.3.1

Change the frame rate of the document to 30 fps.

Method of Completion:

1. Click Modify > Document
2. Click in the text box for Frame Rate
3. Type **30**
4. Click OK

Flash.3.4.2

Using the Properties Panel, change the color of the Stage to gray (#CCCCCC).

Method of Completion:

1. Click the Stage color swatch on the Properties panel
2. Click 5th swatch down first column, gray, #CCCCCC

Flash.3.5.1

Change the Ruler units for this document from pixels to points.

Method of Completion:

1. Click Modify > Document

2. Click the drop-down arrow for Ruler units:
3. Click Points
4. Click OK

Flash.4.2.1

Change the upper-right corner of the rectangle to a curve point.

Method of Completion:

1. Click on the Sub-Selection tool in the Tools Panel
2. Click on the rectangle to select it
3. Click on the upper-right corner point while holding the Alt key (Option key for Mac)
4. Click and drag the corner point (becomes a bezier handle) to create the curve point

Flash.4.3.2

Import the file *lakes.jpg* to the Library.

Method of Completion:

1. Click File > Import > Import to Library
2. Click *lakes.jpg*
3. Click Open

Flash.4.8.1

Change the transparency of the circle button to 40%.

Method of Completion:

1. Click to select the button symbol on the Stage
2. Click to expand the Color Effect section of the Properties panel
3. Click the drop down menu for Style
4. Click Alpha
5. Click in the Alpha Percentage text field
6. Type **40**

Flash.4.9.1

Mask the *lake* layer with the *Highland* layer.

Method of Completion:

1. Click on the *Highland* layer (if necessary)
2. Click Modify > Timeline > Layer Properties
3. Click on the Mask option
4. Click OK
5. Click and drag the *lake* layer up and drop under the *Highland* layer (so that it appears indented and shows the blue masked icon)

Flash.4.12.2

Apply a standard Fade In effect to the WAV file named *welcomelakes*, located on the layer named *voice*.
(Note: Accept all other default settings.)

Method of Completion:

1. Click on any frame in the voice layer
2. Click on the Effect drop-down menu in the Sound category of the Properties Panel
3. Click Fade In
