What Are We Learning in class? January 2019

Reading Topics: Identify Main Idea & Key Details in Literature: Identify characters, setting and main events, story structure; Identify Main Idea & Key Details in Literature: Using Text & Graphic Features

Writing: Narrative writing about Literature, Opinion writing with informational text

Math Topics: Review: Read, Represent, Write and Count Numbers 11-20, Describe and compare measurable attributes: bigger/smaller, longer/shorter, taller/ shorter. Practice math facts to 10 (e.g. $4+4=8$, $6+4=10$, $10-2=8$, $8-5=3$)

Science Topics: Earth in Space and Time; Development of Living Organisms (baby to adult in animals, plants & people.)

Social Studies Topics: The World in Spatial Terms: Physical Systems- Maps & Globes, Earth; Historical Knowledge: presidents & patriots,

Academic Fluency Homework practice is recommended for ALL students.

Parents: Please help your child to complete their homework DAILY.

Please practice the following as needed to be fluent. (Fluent means reading/writing with no hesitation!):

- Recognizing & printing Uppercase and lowercase letters CORRECTLY.
- Recognizing Uppercase and lowercase sounds – including short and long vowels!
- Reading Numbers 0-20 and dot cards 0-20, printing 0-20 correctly!
- Blending to read! CVC words (e.g. c-a-t) and Word Family Words (e.g. dip, zip, skip, ship)
- Sight Words: 51-75 (3rd set of 25 words)
