

THE FOUR STEPS OF ART CRITICISM



DISCUSS

What is the value of using the four steps of art criticism when looking at art?

Description Analysis Interpretation Evaluation

Step One: Description

- Objectively describe the contents and physical characteristics of the artwork
- Do not interpret or discuss the elements and principles of art at this stage



Step Two: Analysis

- Analyze the composition
- Use the elements and principles to guide your looking
- <u>Elements of Art</u>: Line, Shape, Color, Texture, Value, Space, Form
- Principles of Design:
 Contrast, Emphasis, Unity,
 Movement, Variety, Pattern,
 Proportion, Balance



Step Three: Interpretation

- What does the artwork mean? What is the artist trying to say?
- Describe the story, meaning, message, idea, mood, and/or feelings in the artwork.
- Historical and art historical relationships
- Opinions backed up by evidence from the artwork.



Step Four: Evaluation


- Your judgment about the artwork
- What is effective or ineffective in the work?
- What is the artwork's value?
- Opinion supported by evidence in the artwork.






