Reading

This week we will focus on using information gained from illustrations to enhance our understanding of a story. The students will answer questions using clues from the illustrations. They will also be given a page of the story with the words covered. They will use the picture clues to predict what the missing text would say. This would be a fun activity to try with a book at home! For phonics, we will continue learning about "the bossy r" and focus on or/ore words (horn, more). Our vocabulary skill will be the prefix over-, which means 'above/beyond" (overjoyed, overcooked).

Last week we started working on friendly letters to help us practice using commas in places, dates, greetings, and closings. Now that we have practiced the format, the students will have the option of writing friendly letters as part of our "Work on Writing" center. Don't be surprised if your child starts bringing home letters to be mailed! All you'll need to do is add the recipient's address and a stamp!

This week, we will learn how to use commas in a series. (For example: She plays baseball, soccer, and basketball.)

Math

We will wrap up our unit on measuring length using the U.S. Customary System. The students have really enjoyed this hands-on unit and have developed a strong understanding of when/how to use the different units and tools. We will review on Tuesday and take the test on Wednesday.

At the end of the week, we will begin Chapter 9, which will take us into measuring length using the Metric System. I have referred to each measurement system as a "family, " so the students have been eager to meet the members of the Metric family, including centimeter and meter.
