Reading/Language Arts

Last week we started working with fables to help us describe the overall structure of a fiction story. This week, we will continue to focus on this unique genre as we learn how to determine the central message, lesson, or moral of a story. To do this, we will recount (Common Core's word for "retell") a story and use the major events to guide us to the story's theme. We will use a bubblegum metaphor to think about "what sticks" with us after reading the story. What lesson can we take with us and apply to our own lives?
