## Reading/Language Arts

This week in reading we are going to focus on identifying the main idea in informational texts. We will use a pizza metaphor to differentiate between the whole main idea and a main idea "slice." Each paragraph or section of the text has its own focus, but they all relate back to the overall main idea. can be one of the trickiest comprehension skills in $2^{\text {nd }}$ grade. Many students can easily tell you details from a story, but most have a difficult time determining the main idea. As you are reading at home, help your child identify the main idea. If your child keeps pointing out details, guide him/her to the main idea by asking "What do all these details have in common?"


## Social Studies/Science

This week in science we will be learning how to prepare for severe weather storms. Some of the storms we will learn about include thunderstorms, hurricanes, tornadoes, and blizzards. We will also learn about how these dangerous storms are formed and how to stay safe during the storms.
