Reading/Language Arts

This week we will review all of the skills from the past few weeks and take our Unit 4 Benchmark Test. The first few days will involve reading and analyzing texts. The final day will focus on all of the phonics patterns and rules we have been working on (doubling the final consonant with —ed and — ing; the long-i sound with —igh, -y and -ind; long-e sound with -y at the end; and bossy-r with ar and ore/ore). The final day will also involve reading a complex text and responding in writing.

Language arts skills being covered include: pronouns; subject-verb agreement; forms of the verb "be" (am/is/are; was/were); using commas (city/state; dates; friendly letters; in a series of nouns, verbs or adjectives); and editing sentences.

We will wrap up our unit on measuring length using the U.S. Customary System. We will continue comparing the different units and choosing the most appropriate tool for measuring specific objects (ruler vs yardstick vs measuring tape). We will review on Wednesday and take the test on Thursday.
