Reading/Language Arts

We will read 4 different versions of *The Three Billy Goats Gruff* and use story maps to record the characters, settings, problems, major events, and solutions in each book. We will also look for key elements that repeat, such as sets of 3, onomatopoeia, size order (smallest to largest), and rich vocabulary.
