Reading/Language Arts

This week in reading we will review all of the skills from the past few weeks and take our final Benchmark Test of the year! We will break the test up into smaller chunks and work on one section each day. The first two days will involve reading and analyzing texts. The third day will focus on all of the phonics patterns and rules we have been working on (vowel diphthongs oo, ou, ue, ew; vowel diphthongs oi/oy; vowel diphthongs ow/ou; long vowel patterns; and the final stable syllable – le. The last day will involve reading a complex text and responding in writing.

This week we will also take the Unit 6 Benchmark Test on all of the language arts skills we have been working on: contractions; possessive nouns; possessive pronouns; adjectives versus adverbs; and editing sentences.
