## Reading/Language Arts

We are continuing our unit on fables. The students will work in groups to practice and perform reader's theatre scripts of several different fables. Our phonics skill for this week will be reviewing words with shorts vowels e, o, and u, as well as CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant) syllables.

The students have also learned how to represent even numbers as the sum of two equal addends (4+4=8). We call these addition facts "doubles facts."
